Gift Certificate Terms & Conditions

These Terms & Conditions apply to all Paramed Tattoo Gift Certificate purchases, redemptions, consultations, and restorative treatment bookings.

Important Information

- Restorative treatments are structured multi-session treatments.
- All treatments require a consultation and suitability assessment prior to treatment.
- Early treatment stages may involve scar-focused microneedling and inkless scar rejuvenation techniques.
- Final stages may include restorative pigment techniques intended to improve visible contrast irregularities.
- Results vary between individuals.
- Post-surgical scars must generally be a minimum of 6 months healed prior to treatment.
- Treatments are not suitable during pregnancy or breastfeeding.
- Treatments are currently available in Auckland, New Zealand only.

1. Acceptance of Terms

By purchasing, redeeming, or using a Paramed Tattoo Gift Certificate, the purchaser and recipient agree to these Terms & Conditions and acknowledge that restorative treatments require individual assessment and suitability approval prior to treatment commencement.

2. Treatment Suitability

All restorative treatments are subject to a mandatory consultation and clinical suitability assessment prior to booking or treatment. Paramed Tattoo reserves the right to decline treatment, postpone treatment, or modify treatment recommendations where clinically appropriate, unsafe, or unsuitable. Purchase of a Gift Certificate does not guarantee treatment eligibility.

3. Treatment Nature & Results

Paramed Tattoo restorative treatments are structured multi-session treatments designed to improve the appearance of scars, stretch marks, and visible skin irregularities through scar-focused microneedling and restorative pigment techniques. Treatment outcomes vary between individuals and are influenced by factors including scar type, scar age, skin condition, healing response, medical history, lifestyle factors, and aftercare compliance. No specific cosmetic, corrective, or medical outcome is guaranteed.

4. Treatment Process

Restorative tattoo treatments are generally completed across multiple sessions over time. Initial treatment stages may involve scar-focused microneedling or inkless scar rejuvenation techniques intended to support texture refinement and healing behaviour. Final stages may include restorative pigment techniques designed to improve visible contrast irregularities.

5. Medical & Healing Requirements

Recipients must be a minimum of 18 years old, not be pregnant or breastfeeding, and must disclose all relevant medical conditions, medications, allergies, previous procedures, immune disorders, skin conditions, and healing concerns prior to treatment. Post-surgical scars must generally be a minimum of 6 months healed prior to treatment consideration.

6. Auckland Availability

Treatments purchased through this Gift Certificate programme are currently available in Auckland, New Zealand only. Travel, accommodation, transport, childcare, and associated expenses are not included and remain the responsibility of the purchaser or recipient.

7. Treatment Risks

Potential risks include redness, swelling, inflammation, tenderness, irritation, allergic response, infection, delayed healing, hyperpigmentation, hypopigmentation, pigment irregularities, scar aggravation, dissatisfaction with aesthetic outcome, or the need for additional sessions.

8. Gift Certificate Validity

Gift Certificates are valid for 12 months from the date of purchase unless otherwise stated. Unused balances are non-refundable and not redeemable for cash.

9. Refunds & Consumer Rights

Gift Certificate purchases are non-refundable except where required under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 or other applicable New Zealand consumer legislation.

10. Booking & Cancellation Policy

Appointments are subject to availability. Failure to attend appointments, repeated cancellations, late arrivals, or non-compliance with preparation and aftercare instructions may result in forfeited deposits, shortened appointments, delayed treatment timelines, or refusal of further treatment.

11. Digital Delivery

Gift Certificates are delivered digitally via email. Paramed Tattoo is not responsible for incorrect recipient details, spam filtering, email delivery delays, technical interruptions, lost certificates, or unauthorised third-party access after delivery.

12. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted under New Zealand law, Paramed Tattoo is not liable for dissatisfaction relating to subjective cosmetic expectations, allergic reactions, healing complications, pigment retention variation, scar recurrence, fading, or outcomes influenced by factors outside practitioner control.
